Our current balances is \$2,802.83.

We have about \$200 in expenses (coffee fundraiser) and in membership fees to send in.

To promote our coffee fundraiser, we set up a table and gave out samples featuring the blends we are selling, Happy Place, Morning Dew, French Roast at the School BBQ on September 7. The coffee was very well received. As part of our fundraising efforts, we have also promoted the prizes we would like to give away for top sellers, and top selling classrooms.

Volunteers will be asked to purchase an \$11 t-shirt or \$25 polo shirt for wear during volunteer duties. Watch DOGS are not limited to fathers / guardians. Grandfathers, uncles, step-fathers, and other father figures are encouraged to join. Watch DOGS is a nation-wide program in 46 states. It began in the early 90's after the Jonesboro, AR school shooting.

Watch DOGS increases the visibility of dads and dad-figures. Teachers are busy teaching. These men provide an extra set of eyes and a visible presence in the school. Men can commit for a day, a week. They can walk the school during class changes, be in the cafeteria during lunch, go outside with kids during recess.

Mrs. Ward brought up the topic of a monthly staff meeting here at Lisa NORTH. They would like to buy a birthday cake to honor those with birthdays. The PTA would commit to about \$25 per month. This motion was carried. We will begin in October.
