Winterfest. December 13, 6:00 p.m. National Honor Society will sell drinks for \$1 each. We will not sell drinks. Mrs. Ward emphasized that we need to communicate ahead of time about this so that people are prepared with the necessary cash to purchase beverages. Last year, our price was \$6 per person for a meal with a \$24 family cap (immediate family only.) We charged \$8 at the door. We purchased pizza from Marco's and lahmacun from Kabob House (Turkish pizza, also kosher.) We had about \$300 left over. Traditionally, we do not make a profit from this event.

Rose asked for discretion and leverage in making the decision on what meal cost would be this year. More research into our costs is necessary. We agreed. Last year, lahmacun was only \$3; this year she expects it to go up to \$4. It was a very popular choice last year and many people ordered it ahead of time. We tried to have a lot of variety in our pizzas last year including vegetarian. However, near the end of the evening, vegetarian pizzas were leftover, and those who came late were generally unhappy with that choice. We decided that this year we would simplify and only offer pepperoni and cheese, everyone's favorites from last year. We will also buy again from Marco's and Kabob House. The meal will include salad or fruit / apple sauce cup.

We will again sponsor a dessert bake-off. For judging this year, we decided to use a secret panel (Judge's Choice) and a popular vote (People's Choice.) Judge's Choice contestants will need to bring a smaller portion of their dessert to the teacher's lounge for check-in and judging by the secret panel by 5:50. People's Choice winner will be chose by the attendees. Heidi graciously accepted the job of running the dessert table again.
